"CUEA Retired Teachers" Scholarship Application

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY AND EVALUATION

1. Applicants must show a potential for successful use of the scholarship funds.
2. Applicants must present a completed application form with one letter of recommendation from a **college supervisor or master teacher** who is familiar with the applicant's academic performance. Be sure that the letter addresses the four criteria on the recommendation form.
3. Applicants must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Be the son or daughter of a CUEA member, active or retired;
 - b. have a grade point average reflecting academic achievement of at least a 3.0 average (on a scale of 4.0);
 - c. have characteristic traits such as responsibility, reliability, integrity and community involvement;
 - d. have academic and vocational potential.
4. Scholarship recipients must be registered in an approved credentialed teacher education degree program in an accredited institution of higher learning.

INFORMATION CHECKLIST

1. Applications must be submitted on the official CUEA Retired Teachers Scholarship application form. Incomplete applications or applications received later than **4:00PM on MAY 5, 2017** will not be considered.
2. Answer **all** questions and complete **all** blanks in **typed form** or in **ink**.
3. Use **n/a (not applicable)** where questions do not apply.
4. The applicant is responsible for the following:
 - Completed application form
 - Activity records (school and community)
 - Applicant's statement and statement of intent
 - One letter of recommendation from a college supervisor or master teacher
Applicants are advised to carefully select a person who will complete the letter of recommendation accurately. **It is imperative that this letter accurately communicate the applicant's qualities and achievements and reflect the criteria listed on the recommendation form.**
 - Unofficial college transcripts must accompany this application
 - Verification of acceptance in college or university student teaching program.
