### Resolution:

Be sure you sign the CUEA Resolution which will be presented to the CUSD School Board on Wednesday, December 6. Key ideas from the Resolution include the following:



- Superintendent has one of the highest salaries among Orange County Superintendents, while educator's salaries are near the bottom
- Budget priorities are focused on district-level management positions, exceeding the pre-recession level of management, even though CUSD has declined by over 3,000 students
- Education dollars are funneled into the pockets of private consultants, spent for new furniture and equipment (over \$13 million), and purchasing 65 new cars, vans, and buses since 2014-15
